Community Association Paving Maintenance

Extensive repairs to damaged pavers throughout the Estate have been performed in May. Pavers have been lifted/loose by tree roots causing trip hazards. Pavers removed, tree roots exposed, cut, and removed. Pavers re-affixed with river sand.

Landscaping Signage

Estate Management has purchased new signage to be placed in the Community Association Garden Beds & Lawn Areas. The signs include 'Keep Off the Gardens' & 'No Parking on The Grass'. These signs were required to be installed as the Gardeners & Security Guards reported persons walking through and parking vehicles in these areas.

Community Association Facilities Re-Open Post Easing COVID19 Restrictions

The Children's Playground in Basin Reserve has re-opened for use. This has come after NSW Government easing of COVID19 Restrictions. Persons using the Children's Playground have been requested to keep social distancing rules and use hand sanitiser before and after using playground apparatus. Doubles Play is now also allowed on the Raleigh Park Tennis Courts. CA Swimming Pool chain locks have been removed. Only 10 persons can use the pools & spas at a time.
